

COOKIE POLICY

Restaurant Supply Chain Solutions, LLC (“RSCS” or “We”) uses cookies on certain websites it owns or operates (collectively, the “Websites”; individually, the “Site”). By using any of the Websites, you consent to the use of cookies.

RSCS’s Cookie Policy explains what cookies are, what they do, how RSCS uses cookies, and your choices regarding cookies.

What are cookies?

Cookies are small pieces of text placed on your computer or other device by websites you visit. They are widely used in order to make websites work, or work more efficiently, as well as to provide information to the owners of the website or others. A cookie file is stored in your web browser and allows RSCS or a third party to recognize you and make your next visit easier and the Site more useful to you. The entity that places cookies on your browser can then read the information on the cookie that it set.

Cookies are typically classified as either “session cookies” or “persistent cookies.” Session cookies do not stay on your device after you close your browser. Persistent cookies will remain on your device until you delete them or they expire.

How RSCS uses cookies:

When you use and access the Websites, cookie files may be placed in your web browser.

Cookies are used on the Websites to enable certain functions of the Site, provide analytics, improve your user experience, optimize advertising and marketing, and recognize you as a customer.

- (a) Necessary Cookies: Necessary Cookies are necessary for the Websites to function and cannot be disabled. These cookies are essential for enabling user movement around the Websites and providing access to features of the Websites. These cookies do not gather information about you that could be used for marketing purposes, do not remember where you have been on the internet, and do not store any personally identifiable information. If you set your browser to block or alert you about these cookies, some parts of the Websites will not work.
- (b) Functional Cookies: Functional Cookies allow the Websites to provide enhanced functionality and personalization. These cookies may be set by us or by third party providers whose services are added to pages on the Websites. Functional cookies also allow us to remember your preferences and various choices you make on the Websites.

- (c) Analytics Cookies. The Websites use Google Analytics cookies to collect information about how visitors use the Websites. These cookies collect information aggregated anonymous data, which is transmitted to and stored by Google on servers in the United States. - (d) Advertisement/Targeting/Remarketing Cookies. Targeting Cookies may be set through the Websites by our advertising partners, such as Facebook and Google, and are used by those third parties to build a profile of your interests, show you relevant advertisements on other sites, and engage in behavioral advertising. If you choose to not allow these cookies, you will experience less targeted advertising.

What are your choices regarding cookies?

The use of cookies is now standard for most websites. However, if you are uncomfortable with the use of cookies, you can manage and control them through your browser, including removing cookies by deleting them from your browser history cache when you leave the Site. If you'd like to delete cookies or instruct your web browser to delete or refuse cookies, please visit the help pages of your web browser.
